- Alerts officers to potential triggers and ways to calm the individual



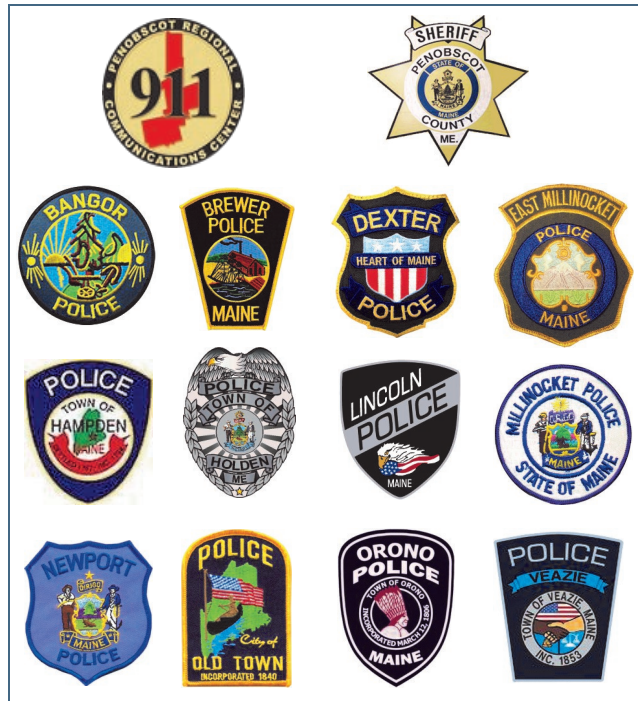
